Support Line Advocate

Female advocates provide crisis counseling, information, referrals, and resources on SARC's 24-hour Support Line. They also respond in-person to survivors seeking medical care in local area hospitals, reporting assaults to law enforcement, or needing support through sexual exploitation and trafficking.

Community Outreach and Tabling (Program currently full)

Help get the word out about SARC programs and services at fairs, community events, and colleges by providing much needed information and resources throughout our service area. Volunteers can choose projects that involve work in the community or projects primarily done from home, providing a sense of flexibility and variety in this role!

Education Program Volunteer (Program full until Spring 2015)

Our education and prevention program is specifically designed for middle school and high school students. Volunteers present this 9-session curriculum with the goal of empowering students to help prevent sexual violence through addressing root causes, attitudes, beliefs, and knowledge of sexual violence.

Case Management

Inform and assist survivors as they move through the social, criminal, and civil systems. Be a source for referrals and resources for survivors as they navigate the often-confusing systems along their path toward healing.

Latin@ Program Case Management

Inform and assist survivors as they move through the social, criminal, and civil systems. Be a source for referrals and resources for the Latin@ community as survivors navigate the often-confusing systems along their path toward healing. Bilingual / bicultural preferred.

Latin@ Services & Outreach Program

Deliver education presentations and outreach about sexual assault and SARC services. Provide training to business employers and community leaders that will increase survivors' access to support and services. Bilingual / bicultural preferred.

Make parent packets for the Education Program, solicit lunches to nourish our volunteers-in-training, or help us organize training materials for other volunteers. There are many on-going projects that could use your help!
